- 1. Request for Drinks Machine:** The ladies from the Monday Club have **asked** about a drinks machine but this is not viable due to a cold water connection. The way forward may be to purchase a couple of stainless steel thermal jugs, some cups and saucers and tea and coffee etc. The cost would be around £60 for the thermal jugs and crockery.
- 2.
