

Report of the Clerk

- 1. Shelving for the Container:** The Clerk has looked at the cost of buying some storage shelving for the container. The industrial type shelving needed will cost around £500.00+vat delivered for the amount needed this is the cheapest quote for dexion longspan. The shelving will be carrying a reasonable weight and so in the interests of health & safety cheaper DIY shelving will not be suitable.
- 2. Skips for Allotments:** The Clerk will be ordering a skip for Lowerclough Street during the next week to remove accumulated rubbish from planting the planters, maintenance of the site and general rubbish. When does the Council wish to order the skips for Pasture Lane & Lower Parkhill?
- 3. Remembrance Garden:** The Clerk took the liberty with the assistance of Mrs. B. Norcross of using some of the spare plants from the planters to plant the Memorial's Walls the level of planting provided by Pendle Council can only be described as sparse. This is possibly a task that the Parish Council takes on each year possibly in conjunction with the friends of Barrowford Park? Would the Committee like this adding to a future agenda for further discussion?
- 4. Planters along the River Wall from Halstead Lane to Colne Road:** The Clerk has spoken to Duncan Seed at Lancashire County Council regarding the first phase of the planters between Church street and he Park Gates and he is quite happy for the second phase to be installed. The Clerk suggested that as there are six spare planters these could be fitted in time for the winter/spring planting.
