

Report of the Clerk

1. **B.W. P. Area Committee:** Applications for grants have to be submitted to Peter Atkinson no later than the 25th April 2008. Following on from last years project it is now time to source funding for phase two the MUGA. The Clerk has talked to Anne Kerrigan portfolio holder for parks and she supports the provision of a MUGA at Bullholme and is actively trying to find additional funding for this project. The Clerk feels that an application for £15,000 would be around the right level.
2. **Lowerclough Street Mill:** The Clerk has met the developers and discussed the boundary of the site. The developer has indicated:
 - All walls will be demolished from the mill side needing little or no access to the allotment site.
 - A security fence will be erected along the boundary until all work is completed.
 - The boundary will eventually consist of a low wall topped with railings.
 - The development will be the last set of plans submitted with three independent blocks and short gardens up to the allotment boundary.
3. **Lancashire County Council:** Aggregate Levy Fund, Barrowford Parish Council's application for £7,500 towards the MUGA has been approved.
