## Works at Barrowford Memorial Park:

- 1. Repainting of older Play Equipment: This work was due to be carried out in July but the weather prohibited the work being carried out the work will be done as soon as the Contractor can reschedule.
- 2. Herb Beds: One of the beds has been replaced and the timbers for the second cut the work will be done as soon as the weather allows.
- 3. Memorial Benches: The two sited at the Salmon Pass viewing area are the next two to be done with name plaques attached.
- 4. Meeting with the Bowling Club: The Chairman and the Clerk met representatives of the Bowling Club and future working and relations were discussed. There are several minor problems with dripping taps and faulty seals within the water system. The Clerk will arrange for these works to be carried out ASAP. A full report on the meeting will be given at a future meeting will be arranged when more information from relevant bodies has been obtained. This item will be added to a future agenda.
- 5. Car Accident within the Park: An elderly gentleman trying to find the Cemetery got confused and ending up on Coronation Walk. He slid done the banking and by the time the Clerk had attended the Police had arrived and rescued his vehicle, very little damage was done to the grass and in view of the age of the gentleman the Clerk will not claim damages. The Council will need to look at no vehicular access signs for the two entrances at the Heritage Centre end of the park. The Clerk will look at the cost of the signs and installation.
- 6. Tree Planting Scheme adjacent to Cemetery: The Clerk is arranging a meeting with Treescapes at Lancashire CC to discuss the project and if will qualify for a grant from the Coronation Woodland Fund.
