Children have been climbing onto the rear slope of the annex causing damage to the roof. The Council needs to look at the options to stop this activity before serious damage is done to the slates. The Clerk has already had to call out a tradesman to repair damage already done to several slates which would have allowed water ingress and potential serious damage to both the insulation and ceiling within the annex.

The Council should try to address the two main points of ingress. Which are via the roof of the extension to the rear of the Annex and via a tree sited on next doors property but near enough to the wall to allow access.

The security camera picked up some of the local youths on the walls and roof and this information and pictures have been passed to the local Policing team. The Clerk has asked that the parents and children be warned of the dangers and that if the offences are seen again then further action will be taken.

Does the Council wish the Clerk to enquire about the fabrication costs for some wall mounted posts and barbed wire to prevent easy access or less effectively some antivandal paint to cover the tops of the walls.
